We are confident that all of our children will behave in a manner which will not entail the enforcement of this Discipline Policy, however please know that we do intend to implement it to its fullest if the need arises. Please read the Discipline Policy with your child(ren), sign the tear off on the bottom and return it with your registration packet.

1. Students should behave in the classroom and in the synagogue in a respectful and responsible manner at all times.
2. Students who disrupt the classroom or disturb other students will be disciplined by the teacher.
3. Each teacher is encouraged to employ whichever strategy he/she finds most effective to achieve optimum classroom decorum.
4. If a student continues to be disruptive, he/she will be sent to meet with the Rabbi. If behavior does not improve, a conference with the parents will be required.
5. In the event that a student is expelled from the Temple Beth Emet Religious School the student forfeits the privilege to participate in any Temple related activities or events. This includes the expectation of an invitation to former classmates B'nai Mitzvah.
