## “Proclaim Liberty throughout the land and to all the inhabitants thereof.” -The Liberty Bell



Last month I attended a ceremony honoring teachers and staff members who had 30 years and more working for the LAUSD. While we were being entertained with a rendition of “The Star Spangled Banner” by the Choral group of the school that was hosting the ceremony, I began to cry. The tears were a result, I’m sure, of what our hostess had said a few minutes before about our dedication to the students of the school district.

As the lyrics and the melody filled the room, I began to think back about the children I had taught, from Armenians to Zulus, Christian to Wicken and all the points in between. I remember I once told my soccer players that what made us members of a championship team was that we had players from all the continents except Antarctica. The variety of SOCES reflects the variety of America. And what a variety America has been for me.

I am a product of the public school systems of Yonkers, New York and the States of New Jersey and California, up to and including part of graduate school. My teachers came from many different places and heritages and I am glad to have joined their ranks. After I stopped crying during the “Star Spangled Banner”, another song came to mind. “Only in America” by Jay and the Americans. A phrase from that song kept repeating itself over and over again, “A man starts with nothing and ends up with you”.

I began my career with the LAUSD, with no money, but a desire to help people. As my dedication became known, doors opened for me. No one said you can’t do this, because you’re too short, too tall, too light, too dark. More so, NO one said, you can’t do this because you are a Jew. These last 16 years, I have worn my Kippah every day to school and even when I thought about not wearing it, word came to me from my students that they respected my commitment and dedication and that I should always wear it.

This reflected the America of the Statue of Liberty, “Give
