This year marks the 75th Anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, when from April 19 to May 16, 1943, residents of the Jewish ghetto in Nazi-occupied Warsaw, Poland staged an armed revolt against Nazi deportations to extermination camps. This was the most significant act of resistance to the Nazis and the Holocaust, and it inspired other revolts in extermination camps and ghettos throughout Nazi-occupied Eastern Europe. The Uprising remains symbolic of collective Jewish resistance where heroic men and women sacrificed their lives to defend their people.
