- 3. Each teacher is encouraged to employ whichever strategy he/she finds most effective to achieve optimum Zoom meeting or room or classroom decorum.
- 4. If a student continues to be disruptive he/she will be sent to meet with the Rabbi. If behavior does not improve, a conference with the parents will be required.
